


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THE PRELUDE

Beatrix Potter



Alan Alexander Milne

A.A Milne wrote the first in a series of books about his own childhood Teddy bear, Winnie the Pooh in 1926, and it is a very well-known fact that Pooh's favourite thing In the whole wide world is honey, a key component in this delicious little smackerel of a cocktail!

MR DARCY Jane Austen

One of the two principal characters in the novel Pride and Prejudice, written by the author in 1813, is Fitzwilliam Darcy, an archetypal, aloof, romantic hero, as quintessentially English as Afternoon Tea.

CANDY & APATHY Emily Bronte

Wuthering Heights, one of the most famous novels ever written about unrequited love, was penned by the author between 1845-1846. This creation reflects the tumultuous Journey of most, if not all the characters as the sweetness of love and passion dissolves into destructive emotional apathy. Despite its subject, this cocktail is a fun and joyful

affair.

THE JAMAICA G'INN Daphne Du Maurier

The Jamaica Inn, known to have been frequented by smugglers, and its rugged location on Bodmin Moor, was the inspiration behind the author's famous novel of the same name. This cocktail encompasses a taste of the copious tipples undoubtedly enjoyed by its patrons, on many a windswept night.

ISABELLA POT OF BASIL Cohn Leats

This poem was written in 1818, and lavishly depicts romantic ideals. The main subject has been a choice of muse, portrayed in paintings by various artists, many of which are still on public display today. The aromatic inclusion of the fragrant herb basil is a wonderful compliment to this refreshing cocktail.

ROMANTIC William Wordsworth

This popular poet was born in 1770, and his first poem, An Evening Walk, was published in 1793. His life's work is accredited to being hugely influential in the launch of the Romantic age of English literature. The gorgeous hue of this delectable concoction represents the colour of love and romance.

VICTORIAN LEMONADE Alfred Lord Tennyson

Born in 1809, Tennyson became the Poet Laureate of Great Britain during much of Queen Victoria's Reign, and held that title for 42 years. To this day, no other poet in history has retained the title for longer. This cocktail has been composed in recognition of this remarkable era.


BUTTER BEER Joanne Lathleen Rowling
